
Why is the half-meter hole in the wall on level 6 in Block C kept secret from owners by deliberately covering it with simple panel and not repaired in a timely manner?




SP52948 Block C Level 6 large hole in wall on 9th of February 2019






SP52948 Block C Level 6 large hole in wall simply riveted by large panel and no further repairs occurred on 16^{th} of February 2019
